- "It's something you do with others and to others."
- "One who forms a judgment but cannot explain it clearly might as well never thought at all on the subject."

Public speaking means...

- Making your ideas public
- Expressing your ideas
- Sharing them with people
- Influencing people
- Communicating with people



Why is public speaking needed in modern times?



Today's world is dominated by other forms of communication-email, faxes, sms messages, short notes, truncated language

- Today's world is suffering from miscommunication and lack of human contact.
- Now with the growth of the Internet and the tendency to globalization, there is a strong need for good communication skills

What are the main two characteristics of public speaking?

It is interactive

It is a social process

It involves engaging other people too.

Speakers adapt their subject, & language to their audience. Listeners are involved by responding before, during & after the speech

It is a social process

 As a speaker you are part of a community. By making a speech you are engaged in its problems & solutions. It means expressing & fighting for what you believe in

Why is public speaking important for a university student?



It is important because...

- 1. You can improve your unexplored potential for speaking in public
- 2. You can improve the speaking skills required in your studies
- 3. You can boost your self-confidence
- 4. You will feel part of a community
- 5. You will improve your listening skills

Also outside academia...

- 6. As a researcher you will need it to make presentations on your work
- 7. As a professional you will need it at the workplace
- 8. As an adult you may become involved in social/athletic/music communities

9. As a believer in democracy you will need it "to sustain our democratic way of life"

An ethical speaker should ...

- Speak honestly
- Speak accurately
- Be genuinely concerned about his/her audience
- Examine his/her motives
- Not plagiarize
- Engage in dialogue
