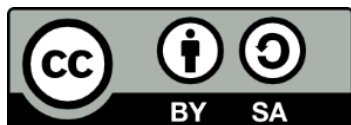

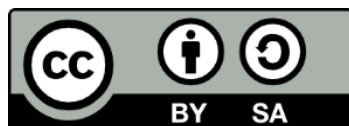
# Tenses-1

An important idea in the definition of a university is the notion of academic freedom. The first documentary evidence of this comes early in the life of the first university. University of Bologna 1\_\_\_\_\_ (**adopt**) an academic charter, the *Constitutio Habita*, in 1158 or 1155, which 2\_\_\_\_\_ (**guarantee**) the right of a traveling scholar to unhindered passage in the interests of education. Today this 3\_\_\_\_\_ (**claim**) as the origin of "academic freedom". This 4\_\_\_\_\_ (**now widely recognize**) internationally, when on 18 September 1988 430 University Rectors signed the *Magna Charta Universitatum*, 5\_\_\_\_\_ (**mark**) the 900th anniversary of Bologna's foundation.
