

#### **Tenses-1**

An important idea in the definition of a university is the notion of academic freedom. The first documentary evidence of this comes early in the life of the first university. University of Bologna 1\_\_\_\_\_ (adopt) an academic charter, the Constitutio Habita, in 1158 or 1155, which 2 (guarantee) the right of a traveling scholar to unhindered passage in the interests of education. Today this 3\_\_\_\_\_ (claim) as the origin of "academic freedom". This 4 (now widely recognize) internationally, when on 18 September 1988 430 University Rectors signed the Magna Charta Universitatum, 5\_\_\_\_\_ (mark) the 900th anniversary of Bologna's foundation.
