

## **Tenses-2**

Findings – The survey 11 FIND that only 22 per cent of students 12 ENTER wage labour, while inactivity rate is very high, 13 AMOUNT to 55 per cent. Although many students assess employability after graduation as the main motivation for working, the majority of them 14 DISCOURAGE to search for a job because of schedule conflicts and lack of job opportunities.
Practical implications – In breaking this deadlock the article explores the idea of 15 RESTRUCTURE the internal labour market in Greek universities by 16 EXPAND services and offering part-time job positions to their students.
Originality/value – 17 GIVE the dearth of empirical research on youth employment in Greece, this paper aims 18 CONTRIBUTE to debates in the wider academic community on the issue of preparing young, well-educated people to enter the Greek labour market.
